## Residential Drywall earns flex-work-policy award

**TAMPA, FLA.** – Residential Drywall Inc. has received an honorable mention in the 2007 Alfred P. Sloan Awards for Business Excellence in Workplace Flexibility for the Tampa Bay area.

According to Angela Sanchez, vice president of sales, this award ranks the Tampa-based company in the top 20 percent of employers nationally in terms of flexible work programs, policies and culture.

The award recognizes employers that use workplace flexibility to meet employer and employee goals. employees. One Residential Drywall employee wrote that flexible hours and being allowed to telecommute make it possible for her to grow professionally while raising her family.

Residential Drywall provides fully paid medical insurance for each employee, as well as laptop computers linked to the office server to facilitate flexible working hours. Both factors play a major role in the company's high employee-retention rate.

Residential Drywall received the award at the recent 2007 Annual Workforce Conference at the Stetson University College of Law in St. Petersburg, Fla., and will be recognized with all Alfred P. Sloan Awards recipients in the Feb. 13 edition of *USA Today*.

Founded in 1999 by Michael Mobley, Residential Drywall currently serves more than 150 home builders in 12 Florida counties and generated \$26 million in revenue last year. It has completed more than 30,000 residential projects since its inception.

In 2002, Residential Drywall created a window-sill division, which installs marble, Corian and travertine sills.

Residential Drywall is a member of 12 builders associations in the central Florida area. Last year, the *Tampa Bay Business Journal* named it a finalist for Small Business of the Year in the building-trade category, and was a semi-finalist in the Best Places to Work awards program sponsored by the Greater Tampa Chamber of Commerce.
