**The B & W Rexall Drugs U.S. Post Office c. u. was informed that all the other Citrus County Post Offices wouldn't be offering extended hours. Realizing how much this service was in demand in the area, the B & W Rexall Drugs U.S. Post Office c. u. decided to remain open until midnight.**

**The Gainesville Distribution mail center contacted the B & W Rexall U.S. Post Office c. u. to thank them for offering to remain open; and informed them of how grateful the other local Post Offices were. The B & W Rexall Drugs U.S. Post Office c. u. would like to thank all of the Citrus County Post Offices for posting the information and informing customers of their extended hours.**

**The B & W Rexall Drugs U.S. Post Office c. u. hours are from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., but from 4:00 p.m. to 12:00 a.m. 231 items were postmarked for the April 15<sup>th</sup>; they're assuming 95% appeared to be tax related, due to the frantic nature of the patrons.**

**As midnight neared, Ken Heimann, Owner and Pharmacist of the B & W Rexall Drugs asked Mr. Michael Pugh, Jr., Inverness, to draw the winning name for the Tax Day 32" Flat Screen T.V. Out of 1,932 entry forms that were entered in the giveaway, Denisa Manion, Inverness, was chosen.**
